



CALL TO ARTISTS

ARTISTS' CHOICE Regional Juried Show

August 2 - September 1, 2024

Eligibility This month-long group show at the Foundry's industrial-style space in Washington, DC is open to painting, drawing, mixed media and photography by artists age 18 and up in the greater Washington area (you have to be close enough to deliver your work). One of Washington's premier contemporary galleries, the Foundry promotes the work of emerging and accomplished regional artists.

Work is limited to 36" wide. If accepted it should be professionally presented, with a wire on the back, and works on paper should be framed. There is no theme

All art will be for sale, and the gallery retains a 40% commission. Work may not be removed before the end of the show.

- Applicants may submit up to 5 images.
- Entry Fee: \$40, payable by credit card.
- Open for submissions: May 1, 2024
- Deadline for submissions: June 30, 2024

Delivery Accepted work must be delivered and picked up in person. Shipments cannot be accepted. Please bring accepted work to the gallery on Sunday, July 28, 2024 between 2:00 and 6:00pm.

Show starts Friday, August 2, 2024

Opening reception Saturday, August 3, 4 – 6pm.

Pick-up Unsold work must be picked up in person on Monday, September 2, 2024 between 1:00 and 5:00 pm.

Publicity and opening reception

Foundry Gallery will prepare and send out a press release and otherwise publicize the exhibit. Artists are encouraged to attend the opening reception on Saturday, August 3, 2024 from 4 – 6 pm.

Copyright

Artists retain copyright to their own images. Artists whose work is chosen grant Foundry Gallery permission to use images for promoting the exhibition, the artist, or Foundry Gallery, including use on social media. Artists grant usage as stated without further compensation.
